**Examples of Activities in Each Skill Domain**  
(student must demonstrate 2 activities per skill area)

(Bullets represent suggestions for activities, with your mentor's approval you may deviate from these)

1. Written Communication Skills
  - Research proposal
  - Research paper/lab report
  - Literature review
  - Honors Thesis
  - APA poster preparation
  - Not a required paper for a class
  
2. Research Methodology Skills
  - Experimental design
  - Survey/questionnaire development
  - Data collection, analysis and interpretation
  - Learning and using an assessment tool
  
3. Computer/Technology Skills
  - Novel adaptation of computer programs for research
  - Programming computer software for data collection
  - Use of spreadsheets and data analysis software
  - Creation of graphical representation of data
  - Power point presentation related to research project
  - Web site design
  
4. Oral Communication Skills
  - Development and presentation of a poster
  - Oral presentation on a research topic
  - Didactic instruction in a classroom setting
  - Teaching assistantship
  - Research experience that involves intense interaction with other people (e.g., focus groups)

## Examples of Activities in Each Skill Domain

### 1. Written Communication Skills

- Literature review
- Creation of resource materials or other projects
- Journal of experiences
- Experience summary paper

### 2. Applied Experience

- Documentation of a minimum of 90 hours invested in a community based psychology-related setting.
- Evidence that learning goals were accomplished
  - supervisor's assessment
  - final project creation

### 3. Oral Communication Skills

- Oral presentation (as part of the experience or about the experience)
- Advocacy experience
- Workshop
- Experience that involves intense interaction with other people
